

NOTICE

(Eastport Cemetery Ordinance)

The City of Eastport and the Groundskeeper/Superintendent of the Cemetery hereby reminds us and gives notice of the adoption and amendment of the Cemetery Ordinance on May 10th, 2023 by the Eastport City Council and makes reference to <u>Section 4.2.8</u> and <u>Section 4.2.9</u> which reads as follows:

<u>Section 4.2.8</u> - Any holder of a lot shall not enclose the same with a fence or curbing shall not plant trees or shrubs and shall not in any manner encroach on the driveways and walks of the cemetery. Any of the above-listed items that were put in place prior to the year 200 shall not be removed or damaged by Cemetery staff.

Section 4.2.9 - The Superintendent shall, under the direction of the City Manager's approval, remove any trees, shrubs, plants, or erections of any kind that interfere or encroach upon any driveway or walkway or any adjoining lot.
