VII. NEW BUSINESS

The City Clerk notes that there was only one bid received and the Council President moves forward with the opening of the bid from Downeast Masonry and reads aloud what appears to be an amount of \$28,000.00 but that it is not legible. The City Manager asks to call Howie for verification as she believed this amount to be higher than what was expected. Howie will call the bidder to confirm the amount and will call the City Manager back.

 a) <u>Opening & Award of Bid for the Lowering & Retarring - 22 Manholes</u> <u>MOTION ARCHER</u> <u>SECOND SCOTT EMERY</u> (PASSED 4-0) To table this vote until the Public Works Director, Howie, calls to verify the dollar amount submitted for the bid from Downeast Masonry.

The Public Works Director, Howie, called back at approximately 6:10 p.m. and confirms the amount of \$28,000.00.

Council President asks if it is too late to re-bid. The City Manager and Councilor Archer comments to say that they are getting ready to close down the plants and that it is late in the season for this type of work. The City Manager notes that the funds will come from the Sewer budget which is by user fees and not tax dollars.

MOTION <u>ARCHER</u> **SECOND** <u>SCOTT EMERY</u> (PASSED 4-0) To accept the submitted bid of \$28,000.00 from Downeast Masonry and to authorize the City Manager and the Public Works Director to negotiate with said bidder but that the expense is not to exceed the \$28,000.00.

b) <u>Council Approval for a Write-Off in the Amount of \$125.57 - Sewer Acct. #605</u> <u>MOTION</u> <u>SCOTT EMERY</u> <u>SECOND</u> <u>ARCHER</u> (PASSED 4-0) To approve the write off for an amount of \$125.57 on Sewer Acct. #605 and to authorize the Treasurer, Traci Claroni, to make the necessary adjustment to the account.

c) <u>Opening of City Property for the Special Hunt for Anterless Deer</u> (from 11/26/2018 to 12/8/2018)

MOTION <u>ARCHER</u> SECOND <u>SCOTT EMERY</u> (PASSED 4-0) To authorize and approve the opening of City Property for the Special Hunt for anterless deer from 11/26/2018 to 12/8/2018 and that the locations are to remain the same as last year and those being reflective of the Port Authority property on County Road and a range around the airport. Council also recognizes and accepts there is no change with regard to the cemetery, the parks, and the schools and that there is no hunting allowed. (No parks, no cemeteries, and no schools).

d) <u>Council Approval to Authorize Treasurer, Traci Claroni, to Administer</u> <u>Rural Development Grant for Raye's Mustard Mill Museum</u>

Councilor Archer asks the City Manager if the City would get reimbursed for the administration fees and she responded "no" we do not.

He comments to say that the third truck is for transfers and that they will be updating the manual stretcher to a power lift stretcher and they will also be replacing the monitor with a new one. He also informs that there are new employees and that there some that are attending EMT classes.
