“OVERNIGHT PARKING BAN”
EASTPORT PARKING ORDINANCE

Article 1. Section 113. Snow Removal

“No vehicle shall be parking at anytime on any public streets or ways so as to interfere with or hinder the removal of snow from said street or way by the City plowing, loading or hauling. The Chief of Police may cause any vehicle so parking on any street to be removed and placed in a suitable parking space off the street, at the expense of the owner of such vehicle. And without the City being liable for any damage that may be caused by such removal.”

Article 11. Section 11. Penalties

“No person violating and provision of the Ordinance shall upon conviction, be punished by payment of a fine not to exceed \$100.00, which fine shall be recovered for the use of the City of Eastport.”

This ban will begin on **November 15th, 2023 through April 15th, 2024.**
