Questions Received Regarding RFP and Answers to Said Questions

Questions

- Does the City anticipate installation of curbing and a storm drain system along this sidewalk project?
- Is there topographic survey data available for the project site or will the consultant need to perform this service?
- Who will be responsible for preparation of right of way (ROW) plans?
- Should the consultant include construction administration or construction inspection services in the scope of work?
- Does the City have specific deadline requirements for the project schedule?

Answers

- 1. The consultant would have to determine this during the preliminary engineering, but curbing and drainage would be preferred.
- 2. There is not detailed topographic information available, to my knowledge.
- 3. The consultant would be responsible for the preparation of ROW plans.
- 4. Construction administration and construction services should not be included in the scope of work at this time.
- 5. The consultant should propose a schedule as part of its response to the RFP.
